Robert J. Taylor, Jr., a member of the Senior Executive Service, is the Deputy Director, Plans and Policy, United States Strategic Command, Offutt Air Force Base, Nebraska. He is responsible for shaping and implementing national security policies, strategies and plans in accordance with the execution of the Command's assigned missions. These missions include the global integration of strategic deterrence, nuclear operations, global strike, space operations, missile defense, and joint electromagnetic spectrum operations.

The Deputy Director represents the Director, Plans and Policy and the Commander, USSTRATCOM at senior level departmental, interagency and international planning, policy and strategy meetings and events. In accordance with the Commander's vision and intent, Mr. Taylor drives policy, integrates global capabilities into Department of Defense approved campaign and contingency plans and advocates for the sustainment and modernization of a resilient, well-equipped, trained combat-ready force.

Mr. Taylor is a Distinguished Military Graduate of the Army ROTC program at the University of Nebraska at Kearney. He has earned two Master of Arts degrees in Military Art and Science. He has served in key staff positions in Army and Joint units from battalion to unified command level, and has commanded Army units from platoon to brigade. Mr. Taylor has four combat tours in Iraq, deployed special mission capabilities globally, and has an operational deployment as part of Stabilization Force 4-5 in Bosnia-Herzegovina.
