Brigadier General Timothy Glynn is the Intelligence Mobilization Assistant, U. S. Strategic Command, Offutt Air Force Base, Neb.

BG Glynn is a native of Sisseton, SD, and is a Distinguished Military Graduate of the University of South Dakota ROTC Department where he accepted a Regular Army commission as a Military Intelligence Officer in the U.S. Army in 1989.

Prior to his position at USSTRATCOM, he served as a Platoon Leader and Assistant Counter-Intelligence Officer for 5th Signal Command, Worms, Germany during Operations Desert Shield and Desert Storm. In 1993,

Glynn returned to South Dakota as a traditional Guardsmen commanding B Company, 2-133 IN and A Troop, 1-113 Cavalry. In 2004, Glynn became an Active Guard Soldier where he has served in an array of positions to include the 67th Troop Command S3, the 2nd Brigade S2, S3, and XO. Glynn's Senior Commands include the Counterdrug Taskforce, 71st Civil Support Team, Brigade Special Troops Battalion and the 671st Troop Command. Glynn deployed to Afghanistan in 2010 serving as the Embedded Training Team (ETT) Commander responsible for mentoring the Afghan National Police of the Panjshir Province. Glynn is transitioning from the Iowa Army National Guard Chief of Staff to STRATCOM.

BG Glynn has an MBA from Trident University and a Masters of Strategic Studies from the Army War College. He is blessed with the support of Cathleen, his wife of 30 years, his daughter Elizabeth, a Pharmacist at Mercy Hospital in Cedar Rapids, and his son, Cadet Stephen Glynn, A Troop, 1-113 Cavalry.
